

Summary


- Concord has always valued our educational system
- CPS has some of the highest spending per pupil
- Teacher salaries and growth in salaries among the highest
- Our student/teacher ratios are one of the lowest among peers
- Average class size comparable, except CCRSD
- Enrollment is declining and predicted to remain below FY 2020 level going forward
- Latest CPS MCAS Math scores below average vs. peers; English and Science results mid–range vs. peers
- CCRSD SAT scores mid-range vs. peers

CPS – 4^t Highest Per Pupil Spending Growth






Concord Salaries and % Increases Higher Than Most Peers



CPS has one of the lowest student to teacher ratios among peers






Average Class Sizes vs. Peers






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
Staff Growth Higher Than Almost All Peers






2023 CPS MCAS English Results vs. Peers

2023 ELA MCAS Achievement Results, Grades 3-8 % Meeting or Exceeding Expectations




2023 CPS MCAS Science Results vs. Peers

2023 SCI MCAS Scores, Grades 5 & 8 % Meeting or Exceeding Expectations





2023 CPS MCAS Math Results vs. Peers
